As we begin Year 2005 year for this ministry, we want to Praise the Lord for His faithfulness and direction, for the past eight years.

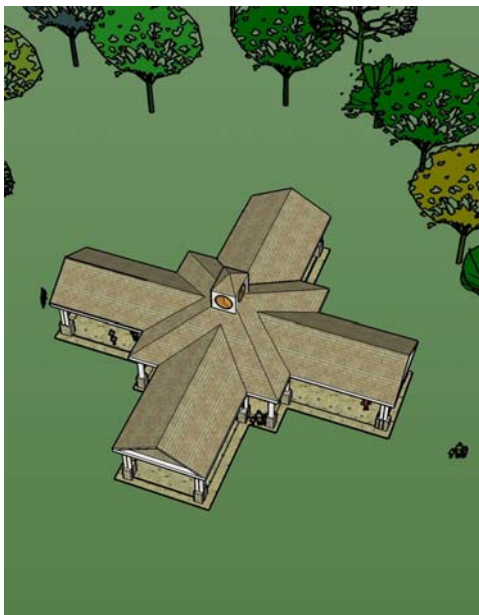

Project Update

Praise the Lord for the blessing the Lord has bestowed on this ministry. Our project load has expanded with many new major projects.

We have revised the **Master Plan** for **Lighthouse Christian Camp**, a ministry of **Shining Light Baptist Church** in Monroe, NC. This dynamic ministry, led by **Pastor Tim Cruse**, is planning for the youth, as well as adults, with a Christian Retreat. The Master Plan calls for a **Tabernacle, Athletic Fields, Dormitory Cabins, a Multi-Purpose Facility, Guest/Family Cabins, "Pilgrim's Progress Walking Trail"**, and future **Senior Center Retirement Development**.

Plans have been completed for a **Gathering Structure** at the pond site, and 3-D images created for the ministry to use in their brochures.



The Lord made available **three residences** that have been moved to the campsite and will be used for **dormitories**. In January the City of Monroe issued building permits for their placement and renovation.

We are about ready to submit final Construction Documents for **Sunrise Baptist Church Addition** in Marian, NC. for **Pastor Darrell Worley**. The MEP drawings are almost completed by the Missionary Tech Team. Please pray for this ministry, as the Devil is placing roadblocks in front of them in the completion of the building.

We have completed the preliminary drawings for a **New Sanctuary** for **Foundation Baptist Church**, under the direction of **Pastor George Smiling** in Columbia, SC. Pastor Smiling is serving with **Death Unto Life Ministries, Inc.**

New Projects

Since our last newsletter, a number of projects have come to our need. We are in various levels of completion on them. Please pray for the CAAA, as the load is getting heavy and currently I am the only architect working on the projects. **Please pray that the Lord impresses on another architect to assist in the ministry.**

At the end of November I traveled to Murfreesboro, TN to meet with **Dr. Shelton Smith** to discuss a building addition to the **Sword of the Lord Ministry** printing operation. This is a very large project for the CAAA ministry. We have completed the Zoning and Building Code Study, as well as an established Floor Plan. Myself and engineers from the

Missionary Tech Team are currently developing the Construction Documents. It is my intent to travel to Murfreesboro in May.

We have been asked to prepare documents for an **Educational Wing** to the existing structure at **Life Gate Baptist Church**, in Hixson, TN. Under the direction of **Pastor James Dunn**, the church is expanding to fill the needs of the growing congregation. **Bro. Bob Utter**, a former Deacon at People's Baptist Church, contacted us about this project.

At **Calvary Baptist Church** in Scottsville, VA, under the direction of **Pastor David S. Morris**, we have been asked to develop drawings for a new **250 person Sanctuary and Educational Wing**. It is my intension to visit the church this summer for additional photographs and documentation of the facilities. This is a growing church that needs to expand. Please pray for them.

David & Cheryl Shive from **Shive Home Ministries** in Clarksburg, MD have contacted us concerning the redesign of a residence into a **Battered Women's Shelter** in that community. Please pray for this ministry. We have begun preliminary drawings and have received valuable feedback from the Shives.

Finally **Pastor Lonnie Moore** with **Tabernacle Baptist Church** in Nicholasville, KY has contacted us about expanding their facility. It is my hope that this summer, while traveling to Nebraska, we will be able make a side trip and investigate their needs.
