Welcome to Our Readers

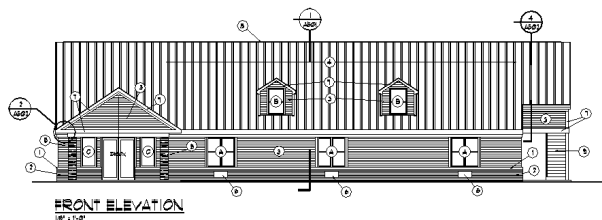

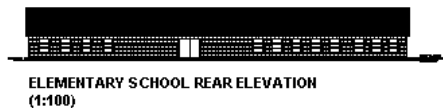
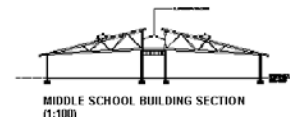
Project Update

Praise the Lord for the blessing the Lord has bestowed on this ministry. Our project load has not expanded due to our focus on two major projects.

Plan revisions for **Camp BIMl (Lee Roberson Center)** in Harrison, TN, under the direction of **Dr. Gerry Baughman**, have been completed and forwarded for the permitting process. Architectural revisions were made after the receipt of the MEP and Structural drawings from our consultants, the **Missionary Tech Team**. MTT is a fine architectural and engineering ministry under the direction of James Foster III. Without their help we would not been able to complete this project.



We have begun the design work on three building projects for the **International Christian Academy** in the **Ivory Coast**, directed by **Elmer Baxter**. We developed the preliminary designs for a new **Elementary School**, a **Middle School**, and a new **Fine Arts Complex**. It has been somewhat difficult in communicating with Br. Elmer, but we have been able to forward CAD drawing electronically using AutoDesk's *Whip!* program. Bro. Baxter and his school faculty are reviewing the documents and will forward their comments back to us for implementation of the final designs



We have completed the preliminary design drawings for a Retirement Home at the ministry complex for **David Wood, Sr.** of **David Wood**

Ministries in Trenton, GA. Bro. Wood is working with an A/E firm in Michigan that will produce the final Construction Documents for the project. If you are not aware of Dr. Wood's ministry, he is responsible for "Operation GO", a soul-winning training session for helping individuals to spread God gift of eternal salvation.
