As we close out the second half of the year 2004 for this ministry, we want to Praise the Lord for His faithfulness and direction. Wonderful and exciting things are happening in this ministry, and as we approach our Lord's return, we are diligent in doing His work on earth.

Project Update

Praise the Lord for the blessing the Lord has bestowed on this ministry. Our project load has expanded with many new major projects.

We have completed the **Master Plan** for **Ambassador Baptist College** in Lattimore, NC, under the direction of **Dr. Ron Comfort**. The plan is comprehensive in planning for the next twenty years growth and development at this God-filled college. Completed notebook sized paperbound Master Plans; along with 24x36 mounted building design drawings have been prepared. I will be delivering the mounted drawings in December when I meet with Dr. Comfort and Bro. Rick Lynn concerning the redesign of a newly purchased building adjacent to the school site.

To assist Ambassador Baptist College in presenting their ministry to families, parents, and students, CAAA has created two animated CAD videos that can be used in their presentations, or downloaded from the ABC website. This image was taken from the video.



Proposed Campus Design

We are revising the **Master Plan** for **Lighthouse Christian Camp**, a ministry of **Shining Light Baptist Church** in Monroe, NC. This dynamic ministry, led by **Pastor Tim Cruse**, is planning for the youth, as well as adults, with a Christian Retreat. The Master Plan calls for a **Tabernacle**, **Athletic Fields**, **Dormitory Cabins**, a **Multi-Purpose Facility**, **Guest/Family Cabins**, "**Pilgrim's Progress Walking Trail**", and future **Senior Center Retirement Development**. Since the last newsletter, the Lord has provided by making available for purchase an adjacent

property that includes a **Boating/Fishing Pond** and a two-story log cabin. Plans are being developed for a **Gathering Structure**, an **amphitheatre**, and walking trails. In addition, the Lord made available **three residences** that have been moved to the campsite and will be used for **dormitories**. The residences were to be demolished for a residential development, and the Lord made them available for free. Praise the Lord!

We have completed the final Construction Documents for **Sunrise Baptist Church Addition** in Marian, NC. for **Pastor Darrell Worley**. We are now awaiting the completion of MEP drawings that were initially not required by the Building Officials. I am working with the Missionary Tech Team on completing these documents. Please pray for this ministry, as the Devil is placing roadblocks in front of them in the completion of the building.

New Projects

Since our last newsletter, a number of projects have come to our need. We are in various levels of completion on them. Please pray for the CAAA, as the load is getting heavy and currently I am the only architect working on the projects. **Please pray that the Lord impresses on another architect to assist in the ministry.**

We have been able to complete the preliminary drawings for **Refuge One-Way Church** in Rocky Mount, NC under the direction of **Pastor Michael Dixon**. This is a small growing church that has purchased an old manufacturing building and is converting the 14,000 SF building into a **Sanctuary and Educational Building**. The congregation is performing all the construction.

We have been asked to prepare documents for an **Educational Wing** to the existing structure at **Life Gate Baptist Church**, in Hixson, TN. Under the direction of **Pastor James Dunn**, the church is expanding to fill the needs of the growing congregation. **Bro. Bob Utter**, a former Deacon at People's Baptist Church, contacted us about this project.

This past August I was privileged to travel to Havre, MT to work at the **Anchor Academy for Boys Camp (ACC)**. Under the direction of **Pastor Trevor Spencer** and **Bro. Dennis McElwrath**, this ministry is a blessing for young men that have trouble with authority. Both Pastor Trevor and Bro. Dennis worked in the Roloff Ministries and saw a need for such a facility in the open-fields of Montana. Located at a former Air Force Strategic Air Command base, the camp is renovating a vast number of structures.

Seventeen members of **People's Baptist Church** spent a week assisting the ministry in a variety of needs. The CAAA has provided drawings for the relocation of the existing school and General offices. We also have over a dozen projects that will take place over the course of the next five years. The largest is the renovation of a Radar Tower into a five-story Dormitory. **Bro. David and Debby Newby**, former members of PBC are on staff at this ministry. Please pray for this ministry.

In Columbia, SC, we are working on the preliminary drawings for a **New Sanctuary for Foundation Baptist Church**, under the direction of **Pastor George Smiling**. We are currently redesigning the Site Plan and Floor Plan to meet the needs of this growing ministry. The drawings are expected to be complete by the beginning of December. Pastor Smiling is serving with **Death Unto Life Ministries, Inc.**

At **Calvary Baptist Church** in Scottsville, VA, under the direction of **Pastor David S. Morris**, we have been asked to develop drawings for a new **250 person Sanctuary and Educational Wing**. This is a growing church that needs to expand. Please pray for them.

At the end of November I will be traveling to Murfreesboro, TN to meet with **Dr. Shelton Smith** to discuss a building addition to the **Sword of the Lord Ministry** printing operation. This is a large project that I will be working with the Missionary Tech Team to complete.

Finally, **David & Cheryl Shive** from **Shive Home Ministries** in Clarksburg, MD have contacted us concerning the redesign of a residence into a **Battered Women's Shelter** in that community. Please pray for this ministry. When they are able to provide needed documentation on the existing building, we will be able to begin design work.
