## Project Update

The month of November continued to be a busy time for us. Praise the Lord for the many Christian workers that gave of their time to complete the needed documents.

**Pastor Orlando Rivera at Dorando Bible Baptist Church**, Dorando Puerto Rico, reports that the construction of their new church building has begun. We are looking forward to celebrating with them this summer in their completed structure.

At **Maranatha Baptist Church**, Okinawa, Japan, **Pastor Dan Mouw** is awaiting the final electrical drawings to obtain the building permit. We have forwarded revised architectural, structural and plumbing drawings. Special thanks goes to Bill Winglar, working with the Missionary TECH Team, for developing the electrical drawings. The drawings are expected to be mailed out before Christmas.

Dr. Clayton Shumpert and CLAIM ministry volunteers will be constructing this facility. If you or anyone else is interested in working on this project please contact Dr. Shumpert at 706.965.7090 for further information. We look forward to going to Okinawa this summer and helping in this major construction project.

The preliminary floor plans and elevations for the new **500 person Church Building** have been completed and are under review by

Pastor Mouw and his Construction Board. We are awaiting final determination on the required structural system so that this project can continue. The church will be located adjacent to the Fellowship Hall building.

After the first of the year I will be meeting with **Dr. J.D. Norris** and the Deacon Board of the **Virginia Beach (VA) Free Will Baptist Church** to discuss the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall expansion project. Pray for this growing church and that these expansion plans can be implemented in the near future.

This past month I had the pleasure of meeting with **Pastor Michael Dixon of Refuge One Way Church** to review their needs for a new structure in Rocky Mount, NC. We have received the necessary site plan information and will begin the preliminary site analysis and schematic plan development for a 300+ person sanctuary. This congregation is currently meeting in crowded conditions. Please pray for their needs to be met.

Two other projects are under review and if possible will begin after the first of the year.

**Please be in prayer for all of these projects and the decisions that must be made by all these churches. By following God's will, all things are possible!**
